

On Site Registration Information

Advance ticket sales are closed, but you can still bring your group! Please read the info below for the smoothest on site experience.

Purchasing Tickets

- Tickets will be sold on a first come, first serve basis at the Life Teen tables outside the park gates on Saturday from 10:00am-12:00noon.
- We have plenty of tickets available so you shouldn't have to worry about your group not getting in.
- You must arrive prior to 12:00noon in order to purchase tickets on site.
- When you arrive, go to the **Last Minute Lane** at the Life Teen registration area to register your group and purchase your tickets and wristbands.
- You must have signed participant agreement/liability forms in hand for all members of your group (including adults) in order to purchase your tickets, so please plan accordingly. Minors' forms must be signed by a parent or legal guardian. We cannot give you any tickets or wristbands until we have received the liability forms for every member in your group.
- You must also bring **payment in full** for all tickets and wristbands. Acceptable forms of payment are check (made out to Life Teen), credit card, or cash, though cash is not preferred.
- Cost is \$60 for the ticket/wristband combo. Cost is \$30 for the wristband only. The wristband only option is for season pass holders who already have a ticket for entrance into the park.
- All ticket purchases for your group must be made at one time, so please have all forms and payments prepared to make the purchase all at once.
- The minimum group size allowed is 3 people (at least 1 chaperone and 2 youth).
- The required chaperone to youth ratio is at least 1 chaperone for up to every 8 youth and all chaperone attending with your group must be at least 21 years or older and in compliance with your (Arch) Diocesan Safe Environment policies. You will be required to sign a form on site stating that this is the case.

Schedule

- After you purchase your tickets, the day is free for you to enjoy the park with your group.
- Please note that Six Flags does not allow outside food or beverage to be brought into the park.
- Doors at the Golden Bear Theater will open for the event at 6:30pm and the event begins at 7:00pm. The event will end at 9:00pm.
- Please note two important changes to the schedule for this year:
 - 1. There is no Mass at the event this year.
 - 2. The park is open later than usual, so after the event ends, you are free to enjoy the park again with your group if you choose. The park is open until midnight.
- Finally, we have a video project happening at Six Flags during the event that we wanted to make all group leaders aware of. Everyone's favorite uptight evangelist, Abrasive Abner, will be joining us at Inspiration this year! If you're unfamiliar with him, he's quite the character -- you can watch some of his videos, like this one, on our YouTube channel. He's producing a video, sharing his firsthand experience of a day at Inspiration at Six Flags. He'd love to get your teens' thoughts on-camera throughout the day!
