

On Site Registration Information

Advance ticket sales are closed, but you can still bring your group! Please read the info below for the smoothest on-site experience.

Purchasing Tickets

- Tickets will be sold on a first come, first serve basis at the Life Teen tables outside the park gates from 10:00am-12:00pm on Saturday.
- We have plenty of tickets available so you shouldn't have to worry about your group not getting in.
- You must arrive prior to 12:00noon in order to purchase tickets on site.
- When you arrive, go to the **Last Minute Lane** at the Life Teen registration area to register your group and purchase all tickets and wristbands.
- Please make sure everyone attending (including adults) has filled out and signed the <u>participant agreement form</u>. Minors' forms must be signed by a parent or legal guardian. You must have forms in hand for <u>all</u> members in order to purchase tickets, so please plan accordingly.
- You must also bring **payment in full** for all tickets and wristbands. Acceptable forms of payment are check (made out to Life Teen), credit card, or cash, though cash is not preferred.
- Cost is \$60 for the ticket/wristband combo. Cost is \$30 for the wristband only. The wristband only option is for season pass holders who already have a ticket for entrance into the park.
- All ticket purchases for your group must be made at one time, so please have all forms and payments prepared to make the purchase all at once.
- The minimum group size allowed is 3 people (at least 1 chaperone and 2 youth).
- Additionally, please remember that the required chaperone to youth ratio is at least 1 chaperone for up to
 every 8 youth, and all chaperones attending with your group must be at least 21 years or older and
 in compliance with your (Arch) Diocesan Safe Environment policies. You will be required to sign a form on
 site stating that this is the case.

Schedule

- After you purchase your tickets, the day is free for you to enjoy the park with your group. Because of another
 event that is happening at the park on Saturday, the park will be closed to the general public, which hopefully
 means shorter lines for all the rides!
- Please note that Six Flags does not allow outside food or beverage to be brought into the park.
- Doors at the Zaragoza Theater will open for the event at 6:30pm and the event begins at 7:00pm. The event will end at 9:00pm.
- Please note two important changes to the schedule for this year:
 - 1. There is no Mass at the event this year.
 - 2. The location of the event has changed. It will not be held at Lone Star Lil's Amphitheater as in prior years. It will be held at the Zaragoza Theater, which is located on your left immediately after walking through the front park gates.
