

## PHOTOGRAPHER

- **Where:** Life Teen Camp Covecrest (Tiger, GA), Life Teen Camp Hidden Lake (Dahlonega, GA), Life Teen Camp Wild Sky (Burnett, TX), Life Teen Camp Golden State (Julian, CA) or Life Teen Camp Restore (Abbeville, LA & Kansas City, MO).
- **Who:** One individual at each Life Teen camp location will fill the role of the Photographer. The Photographer is part of Service Crew, which is the crew of people who serve behind the scenes in a variety of roles all summer long to help ensure the camp creates an environment that facilitates a relationship with Christ.
- **Community / Housing:** As a part of Service Crew, the Photographer will attend all possible formation sessions and will report to the Guest Relations Coordinator for tasks and responsibilities. This person will also be housed with other Service Crew members of the same gender.
- **Key Responsibilities:** The Camp Photographer is responsible for the production of photos that capture the atmosphere and the daily activities of the camp, as well as editing and organizing quality photos to be uploaded on social media. Additionally, the Photographer, like all Summer Missionaries, will be responsible for assisting in fundraising efforts for Life Teen to further the mission of leading teens closer to Christ. The main tasks for the Photographer each week include:
  - Maintaining and taking care of photography equipment;
  - Being present throughout the entirety of the camp week and all camp activities to creatively capture photos, including during camper arrivals, obstacles courses, messy games, high ropes, evening sessions, and prayer experiences;
  - Coordinating the weekly group photo as well as parish group photos;
  - Editing photos as necessary and preparing at least 50 photos per day to be uploaded on social media and saved per Life Teen procedures.
- **Success Factors:** The Photographer will have experience in photography, including taking and editing photos. A successful Photographer will have excellent time management and multi-tasking skills and will be able to complete projects on time each week. This person will be prayerful, mission-minded, and obedient and will be professional in capturing photos each week. The Photographer will have the ability to direct a group to efficiently and effectively capture a large group photo, as well as the

ability provide direction to smaller groups of people as needed for other photos captured at camp.

- **Physical Demands:** This role requires extensive work outdoors and daily movement around camp property to capture photos of various camp activities. The role involves the use of photography equipment and requires long periods of computer use while editing photos.
