PROGRAM TEAM

- Where: Life Teen Camp Covecrest (Tiger, GA), Life Teen Camp Hidden Lake (Dahlonega, GA), Life Teen Camp Golden State (Julian, CA), Life Teen Camp Wild Sky (Burnett, TX) or Life Teen Camp Restore (Abbeville, LA & Kansas City, MO).
- Who: Work with a team of 4-6 people to fill the role of Program Team at a
 Life Teen Summer Camp in Georgia and 2-3 at Remote Camps (Golden
 State, Restore, Wild Sky). The Program Team is part of Service Crew, which
 is the crew of people who serve behind the scenes in a variety of roles all
 summer long to help ensure the camp creates an environment that
 facilitates a relationship with Christ.
- **Community / Housing:** As a part of Service Crew, the Program Team will attend all possible formation sessions and will report to the Program Coordinator for tasks and responsibilities. Program Team members will also be housed with other Service Crew members of the same gender.
- **Key Responsibilities:** Program Team members play a key role in the efficiency and fluidity of camp, helping to create an environment that facilitates a relationship with Christ through parish-based discipleship. The Program Team assists in organizing and ensuring consistent quality of programming at Life Teen Summer Camps, including taking ownership and responsibility for programmed activities and programmed prayer experiences. Additionally, members of the Program Team, like all Summer Missionaries, will be responsible for assisting in fundraising efforts for Life Teen to further the mission of leading teens closer to Christ. The main tasks for the Program Team each week include:
 - Ensuring safe, timely, and enthusiastic facilitation of low and high ropes challenge courses and other camp activities;
 - Setting up, executing, and cleaning up camp activities, including the obstacle course, messy games, lake time, organized hikes and free time;
 - Assisting with preparations, setup, and cleanup of dynamic and faithful Catholic liturgies and prayer experiences, including Mass, confession, and adoration;
 - Serving as a lifeguard for aquatic activities as needed;
 - Developing and facilitating all camp "gather" and "send" activities that are not prayer experiences as developed in camp programming;
 - Ensuring that the camp property and participants are covered in intercessory prayer.



- Success Factors: Program Team members must have a lifeguard training certification through the American Red Cross or another nationally recognized organization that is valid from at least May 15, 2022 through August 6, 2022. Program Team members must also successfully pass the High Ropes Facilitation Course Training that is taken upon arrival to camp. Serving as a part of the Program Team requires a servant's heart with the ability to work collaboratively as a team and also independently when needed. This prayerful, mission-minded, and obedient team member will have excellent time-management skills and will have a strong ability to take initiative. A successful Program Team member will be motivated to serve humbly however needed and will serve with joy while working long camp days.
- Physical Demands: This role requires extensive daily movement around camp property and frequent participation in physically demanding activities, such as rafting, climbing, and messy games. The role involves extensive work outdoors and moderate lifting up to 50 pounds.
