

WELLNESS ASSISTANT

- **Where:** Life Teen Camp Covecrest (Tiger, GA), Life Teen Camp Hidden Lake (Dahlonega, GA), Life Teen Camp Golden State (Julian, CA), Life Teen Camp Wild Sky (Burnett, TX) or Life Teen Camp Restore (Abbeville, LA & Kansas City, MO)
- **Who:** Two individuals at each of the Life Teen camps in Georgia and one individual at our remote camps (Wild Sky, Golden State, Restore) will assist our camp nurse/medical personnel with their daily tasks and act as the camp guide to help familiarize the nurse with camp grounds and daily activities. The Wellness Assistant is part of Service Crew, which is the crew of people who serve behind the scenes in a variety of roles all summer long to help ensure the camp creates an environment that facilitates a relationship with Christ.
- **Community / Housing:** As a part of Service Crew, the Wellness Assistant will attend all possible formation sessions and will report to the Guest Relations Coordinator for tasks and responsibilities. The Wellness Assistant will also be housed with other Service Crew members of the same gender.
- **Key Responsibilities:** The primary role of the Wellness Assistant is to help set up the camp nurse/medical personnel for success each week. The role includes organizing the nurse's iPad, keeping running stock of materials, and assisting with daily medication logs, supply runs, and basic first-aid. The wellness assistant also assists in other areas of service crew as needed.
- **Success Factors:** The Wellness Assistant will be extremely organized and attentive to detail. First Aid training is a requirement. A successful Wellness Assistant will be able to collaborate with groups while also excelling at individual work. This role requires the ability to be flexible to response to changing, high stress situations.. This person will prayerful, mission-minded, and obedient and will have excellent time-management skills and a strong ability to take initiative. A successful Wellness Assistant will be motivated to serve humbly however needed and will serve with joy while working behind-the-scenes.
- **Physical Demands:** This role requires long periods of computer and phone use in a camp office setting. The role also requires extensive daily movement around camp property.
